

Re: 2007 U.S. Dept. of Housing and Urban Development (HUD)
Supportive Housing Program Grant Application

HUD has released the 2007 SuperNOFA grant application for the Supportive Housing Program. The information is available on the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's Homes and Communities Web site at <http://www.hud.gov/offices/adm/grants/nofa07/grpcoc.cfm>.

HUD provides an allocation for each Continuum of Care each year. This year, agencies in Volusia and Flagler Counties are eligible for a maximum total of \$927,064. Existing programs seeking renewals for 2007 for Volusia and Flagler Counties total \$934,079. There is a Samaritan Bonus equal to 15% of the allocation (\$139,059) for a new housing program for those meeting HUD's definition of Chronically Homeless.

If your agency is interested in submitting a new program for HUD Supportive Housing Program funds for transitional or permanent housing for people who are homeless, the Coalition will provide an overview of the application process on Tuesday, April 10th at 8:30 a.m.
