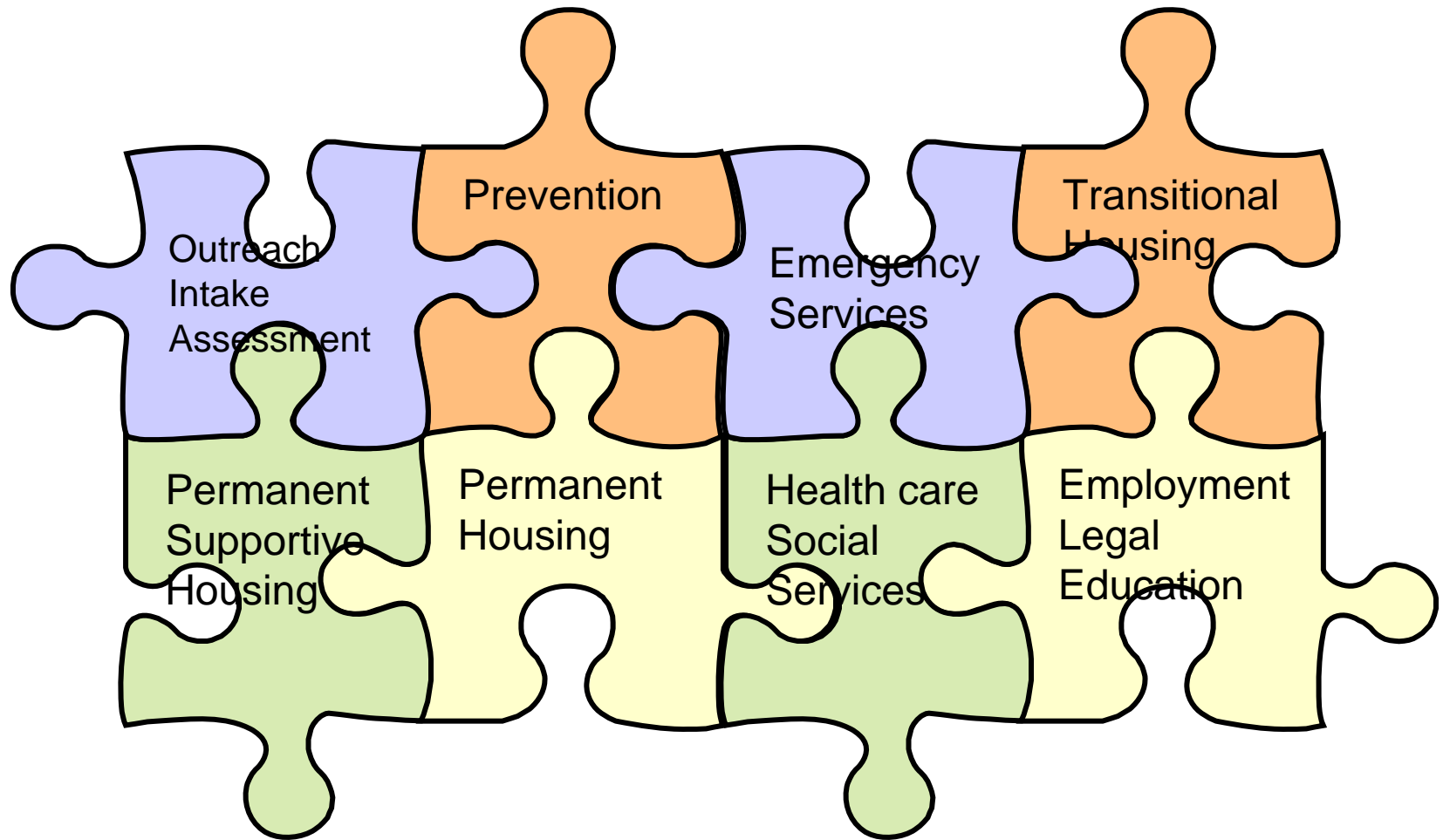

# What's a Continuum of Care?



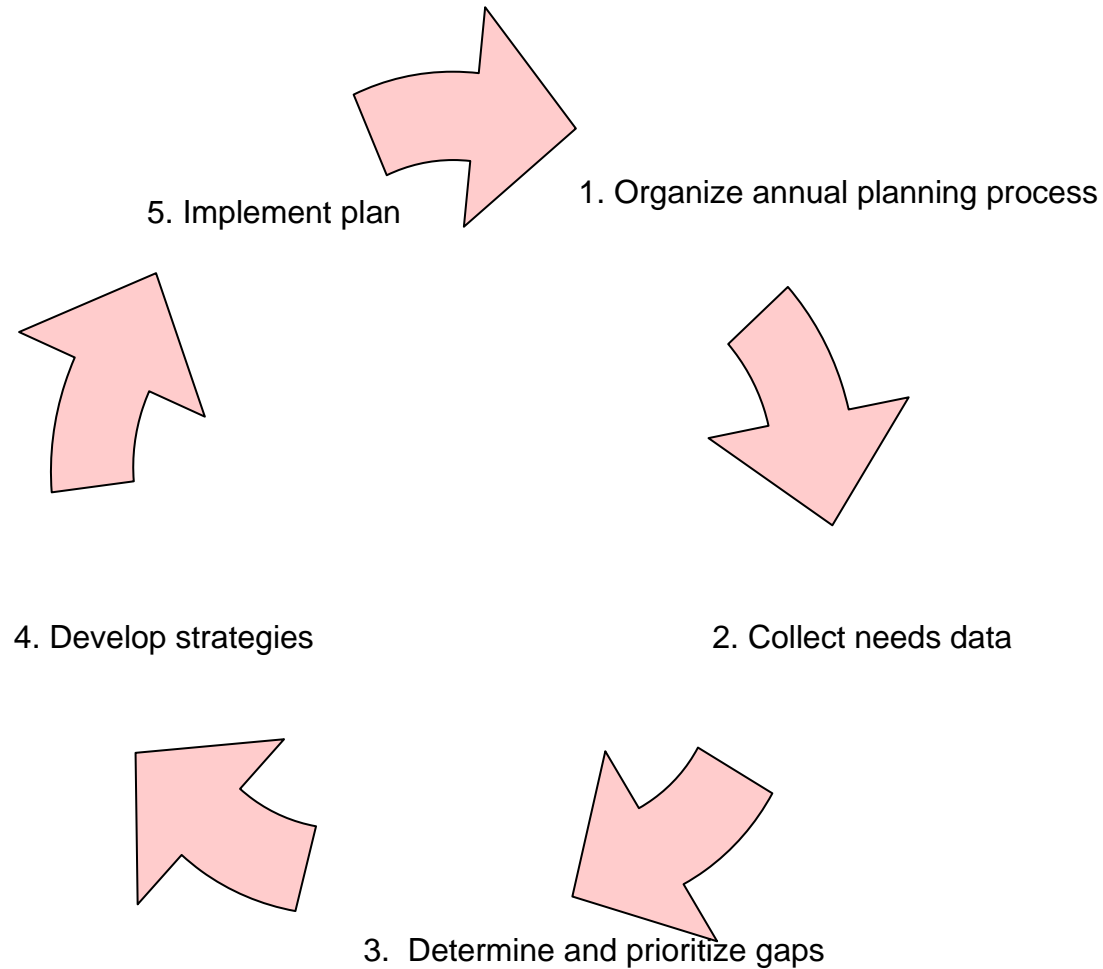


# The CoC Plan

- Key characteristics:

- Long range – 10 year plan is essential
- Based on assessment of needs – get data
- Involves broad base of agencies – emphasis is on “joint” and “coordinated”
- Strategic – focus on ending homelessness
- Sets priorities and realistic goals

# Typical SuperNOFA Timeline

- Due to eSNAPS on November 9
- Planned Submission to HUD on November 2
- Planned Submission to Ranking and Review Committee on October 19 (if necessary; allow for five day appeal process, allow for review by Lead Agency)



# Typical SuperNOFA Timeline

- Award notification
  - According to HUD Renewals will take priority

# Super NOFA Scoring

- Total of 100 points
  - Housing , Services & Structures -14 (14)
  - HMIS – 26 (28)
  - CoC Strategic Planning –22 (16) 51-52
  - Housing Emphasis on Activities – 6 (18)
  - CoC Performance – 32 (28) 52-53
- Number in parenthesis is last year.



# SuperNOFA Side Notes

- HUD can adjust pro rata and priority as it sees fit
- Permanent Housing Bonus
  - Last year Samaritan 138,886



# What is New?

- Renewals will be awarded quickly
- New projects will be awarded separately
- CoC's will not have to rank renewal projects p5
- HHN will be able to reallocate funds to new projects
- Hold Harmless Merger Policy



# What's New

- Certification of Consistency will be submitted by Lead Agency
- ?Utilization of NSP, HUD Vash, ARRA, CDBG-R, HPRP (extra points may be awarded)!!!!!!
- Must address participation in HPRP
- HUD assess project review process, applicant eligibility, capacity, quality, spending history



# What's New

- Samaritan bonus replaced by Permanent Housing Bonus
  - Will allow for disabled individuals and families
  - Chronic homeless housing is still a priority



# What's New

- Transitional Housing (TH) and Supportive Services Only (SSO) projects may serve persons being discharged from institutions (prisons, mental health, hospitals) where resident for more than 90 days (30 days in past)
